
# **Regulated Medical Waste**

If it's soaked or saturated (dripping) or dried and able to flake with blood or bodily fluids or other potentially infectious material (OPIM), it's medical waste.

#### MEDICAL WASTE CONTAINMENT



RMW | Medical waste is defined as red bag or infectious waste containing blood or bodily fluids to a saturation level that is pourable, drippable, squeezable, or flakeable. If the items listed to the right of this poster are not contaminated by fluids to such a level or deemed infectious, they are not classified as RMW waste and should be disposed of in normal trash.
