This includes about 95% of medications given to patients.

## SEND BACK TO PHARMACY HAZARDOUS WASTES

Hazardous wastes that must be separated in the pharmacy, not including DEA-controlled substances or chemotherapy agents.

See Green and Red on Hazardous Medication Form.

- Medications listed in Green are to be sealed in a baggie and returned to pharmacy.
- Medications in Red are to be sealed in a baggie with the medication wrapper and returned to pharmacy.

## OTHER CONTAINERS



### SHARPS

All used sharps capable of cutting or piercing the skin (except those contaminated with chemo waste).



### CHEMO WASTE (TRACE)

Waste that is contaminated through contact with chemotherapeutic agents. Trace chemotherapy waste must contain less than 3% of the original volume.



### BIOHAZARDOUS WASTE

Infectious waste saturated with blood or bodily fluids contained separately in a biohazard bag labeled with the words "Biohazardous Waste"
