The Production Lead will be accountable for managing production workers, facility maintenance, and ongoing floor support and direction. They are accountable for ensuring that co-workers are following all work instructions, policies, and procedures including compliance and safety to ensure the best possible quality outcomes are achieved, troubleshooting all production issues, and seeking to resolve all maintenance, quality, efficiency, or service-related issues as they arise.

- ✓ The ability to identify mechanical problems, make corrections including changing out faulty parts and properly installing new components. Knowledge of motors and electrical/plumbing systems preferred

- ✓ Check-in with employees to make sure they have all the tools and direction to do their job at the start of shift

- ✓ Manage the cleaning and emptying of transporters and ensuring product is inventoried in correct locations
- ✓ Document issues with products, quality or services and ensure examples are retained for root-cause investigation
