HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT SECURE A DRUG PRODUCTS TO FIT YOUR FACILITIES' NEEDS



Wet vs. Dry Format

Secure a Drug containers are delivered to you in one of two ways: Wet or Dry. Once water is added to the Dry version, the formulas become the same, denaturing both solid and liquid medications. **Knowing which product format to choose depends on what matters most to you: cost or convenience?**



WET FORMAT

The Wet format comes pre-filled with water and our activated carbon solution. The only action needed prior to medication disposal is to unscrew the lid.

PRO: Product comes ready to useCON: Higher shipping cost due to weight of product



DRY FORMAT

The Dry format does <u>not</u> come pre-filled with water, just the dry carbon solution. Add warm water up to the labeled fill-line prior to initial disposal. Once water is added, begin disposing medications.

PRO: Lighter container, leading to lower shipping costCON: Customer is required to add water before initial use

Container Size

Container size selection is typically based on monthly usage. In certain facilities (like hospitals), product turnover could range from once a month to once a week.

Considerations to decide:

- How much does your facility waste weekly or monthly?
- Do certain departments or locations provide and waste high or low volumes of drugs?
- What departments or units need different sizes?

Common Facility Types	Smaller volume generators: Surgery centers, doctor's offices, vets, etc.	Most common in hospital setting: PACU, ED, OR, MedSurg, Post OP, Pre OP	Pharmacy and L&D	NarcVault, purging bulk medications

NOTE: These capacities are based on the size of an Advil tablet and should be viewed as a maximum recommended qty of medications, as sizes do vary.

Secure Mounting

Diversion prevention is an essential component of safe cradle to grave drug disposal. Manufactured with easy-to-clean coated steel, our **Static Lock Bracket** is designed to securely mount Secure a Drug products to a wall in a fixed position, eliminating risk of unauthorized removal.

Questions to ask:

- Where is your Secure a Drug going to be located?
- Is it in a locked room, open to all staff, or in a public access area?
- Who has access to this room?

Compatible with both 2L and 4L containers.

Robust construction reinforces security in any mounted location.

Key lockable with inbuilt lock. No padlock or additional locking mechanism required.
